


This manual describes the procedure to install the Sport Grille onto the Impreza.


Be sure to read this manual before installing the product, and correctly install the product according to the instructions.


# **Component Parts**



**M** Installation Precautions For your safety, important instructions that should be observed are denoted by the following symbols in this manual. CAUTION ......This symbol denotes a risk of danger that may cause bodily injury or property damage if the precaution is disregarded. NOTE .....This symbol provides tips you should be aware of so that you can easily and quickly install the product. ha 1. Park the vehicle on level ground, apply the parking brake, and chock the wheels. 2. Organize and keep the removed vehicle parts including screws, bolts and nuts in separate containers so that those small parts will not be lost and can be restored correctly. In addition, be extremely careful not to damage the vehicle or the removed parts. 3. Handle the battery according to the service manual. 4. In order to prevent damage to the vehicle parts and the product, be sure to use protective sheets when removing and installing them. When installing the parts: After the completion of the installation: • Use the tools that are the right size · Pay attention to the back side and do not · Be sure to restore all the vehicle parts that have been for the operation. allow any wire harness to get caught. removed. æ - 🕂 CAUTION Follow the instructions in the service manual. **Tools Required** Combination wrench (10 mm), Phillips and flat-head screwdrivers, Torque screwdriver, Clip remover, Protective tape, and Protective sheets or Blankets.










(1)Remove the three plastic clips, and detach the cover.

# 3. Applying Protective Tape

- (1)Apply protective tape to the shaded area as shown in the illustration.
- (2)Perform the same for the other side.



### 4. Removing the Front Bumper

- (1) Remove the plastic clip A from the four locations and clip B from the one location in order to unfasten the front bumper, and create an opening by partially detaching the front bumper and fender liner so that your hand can access the fog light.
- (2) Perform the same for the other side.

#### < Vehicles equipped with fog lights and sensors >

- (3)Remove the fog light connector LH and the sensor connector LH.
- $(4)\ensuremath{\mathsf{Perform}}$  the same for the other side.


# - 🕂 CAUTION –

Be extremely careful not to injure your hands or arms when removing the connectors.

This sensor harness is for front side radar.




## < Vehicles equipped with headlight washers >


- (5)Pull out the headlight washer nozzle LH, disengage the claw, and detach the cover.
- (6)Perform the same for the other side.



### < All models >

- (7) Remove the following components from the top of the front bumper: Six bolts, Two plastic clip A, and Four plastic clip B.
- (8)Remove the plastic clip B from the eight locations on the bottom of the bumper.





(9)Disengage the 12 claws (left and right, six claws respectively), and remove the front bumper.

# - \land CAUTION -

- In order to prevent the removed front bumper from being damaged, place and store it on protective sheets or blankets.
- (2) For vehicles equipped with a camera, be sure to disconnect the camera wire harness.

# 5. Removing the Front Grille from the Bumper

- (1) Remove the six screws.
- (2) Disengage the eight claws, and remove the original front grille from the front bumper.


# - 🕂 CAUTION -

In order to prevent the front bumper parts from being damaged, perform the instructions on protective sheets or blankets. (Do the same throughout the rest of the procedure)

# < Vehicles without a camera >

# — 🖗 NOTE —

The removed original front grille will not be reused.




# < Vehicles equipped with a camera >


- (3)Remove the two clips that fasten the camera wire harness.
- (4) Remove the two screws and the camera assembly from the original front grille.

– 🖣 NOTE –

The two screws removed from the camera assembly and the original front grille will not be reused.





- (2) Fasten the top of the front bumper with the following components: Six bolts, Two plastic clip A, and Four plastic clip B.
- (3) Fasten the bottom of the front bumper with the plastic clip B at the eight locations.


Tightening torque: 7.5 N·m (0.8kgf-m, 5.5ft-lb)

# < Vehicles equipped with headlight washers >

- (4)Pull out the headlight washer nozzle, attach the cover to the nozzle, and engage the claw.
- $(5)\ensuremath{\mathsf{Perform}}$  the same for the other side.







## < Vehicles equipped with fog lights and sensors >

- (6)Create an opening by partially detaching the front bumper and fender liner so that your hand can access the fog light, and reconnect both fog light connector LH and sensor connector LH.
- (7) Perform the same for the other side.

# - 🕂 CAUTION –

- (1) Be extremely careful not to injure your hands or arms when reconnecting the connectors.
- (2) Confirm the orientation of the fog light connector, and securely connect it until a click sound can be heard. Failure to do so may cause the fog light to remain off due to poor connector connection.

#### < All models >

- (8) Fasten the front bumper to the vehicle with the plastic clips A (x 4) and B (x 1).
- (9)Perform the same for the other side.

This sensor harness is for front side radar.

## 9. Restoring the Front Upper Cover

(1)Attach the front upper cover to the vehicle, and fasten it with the three plastic clips.

### 10. Restoring the Air Intake Duct

(1)Attach the air intake duct, and fasten it with the two plastic clips.

#### Inspection after Installation

(1) Remove all the protective tape.

- $(2)\ensuremath{\mathsf{Follow}}$  the instructions in the service manual.
- (3)For vehicles equipped the the multi-view monitor system, calibration is required. Refer to the service manual for the instructions on how to calibrate the system, and carry out the calibration.

# - 🕂 CAUTION —

- $\left(1\right)$  Check that the fog lights come on and stay illuminated.
- $\left(2\right)$  Check that camera views are correctly shown on the multifunction display.
- $\left(3\right)$  Double-check that the plastic clips, bolts or parts are not loose.
