

General Service Bulletin (GSB):	Electronic Park Brake Functionality And Engagement
GSB Overview:	The Electronic Parking Brake May Automatic Apply When Shifting To Park

On vehicles equipped with an electronic shifting transmission, the Electronic Park Brake (EPB) may apply when you shift to park (P) without the brake pedal fully pressed to ensure the vehicle does not move. An example of electronic shifting transmissions are vehicles that are equipped with a rotary dial shifter or push button shifter. Due to the nature of the electronic shifting, there may be a slight delay to the engagement of park when selected. This functionality is normal and initiated for safety reasons. The EPB releases with the drive away release function or can be manually released as described under the "Releasing the Electric Parking Brake" in the Brakes section of the vehicle's Owner's Manual.
