Additional Procedures (Rev. A)

FOR: Puerto Rico and US Virgin Islands

PURPOSE:

To announce additional procedures during engine replacement (STAR approval required) on Model Year 2026 Jeep Grand Cherokee (WL) with a **2.0L Hurricane 4 Turbo Engine (Sales Code EC7)** for Warranty (W) claim types ONLY.

TIMING:

Effective Immediately

ACTION:

During engine replacement (STAR approval required), the following actions are to be performed:

1. Drain the Fuel Tank per the instructions found in Service Library under **09 - Engine, 2.0L / Fuel System / Standard Procedure / Draining Fuel Tank**
2. Fill the vehicle with **premium** fuel.

When processing a Warranty claim for a 2.0L Hurricane 4 Turbo engine replacement:

- The Warranty claim will reject for **Message Code RP1 (This LOP must be authorized)**. Once the claim rejects, enter it into "RA" for Warranty Contact Center review.
- **The claim must contain the following LOPs:**
 - Complete Engine: 09-01-01-E1 – 2.0L Hurricane 4 Turbo Engine, Complete - (Causal LOP); **or**
 - Long Block: 09-01-70-E1 – 2.0L Hurricane 4 Turbo Engine, Long Block (Causal LOP)
 - 14-60-01-41 – Drain fuel and refill with premium grade fuel - (Related LOP)
 - 95-14-03-50 – Premium Fuel Fill for repair only – (Claim must include fuel receipt **with the VIN and mileage written on the receipt**) - (Special Service LOP)

Please ensure all affected dealership personnel are aware of this bulletin.
