For all vehicles.

- During PDI the technician finds the alignment not correct after a road test.



NOTICE

Warranty only covers alignments at PDI unless required in conjunction with a warrantable repair
 . Alignment claims submitted without an Alignment Sheet Submission Form will be debited.

Go to VW Hub site, access the “Service” criteria, select the “Alignment Worksheet” link (Figure 1), fill out the form (Figure 2), “add the alignment sheet” and submit the alignment form.

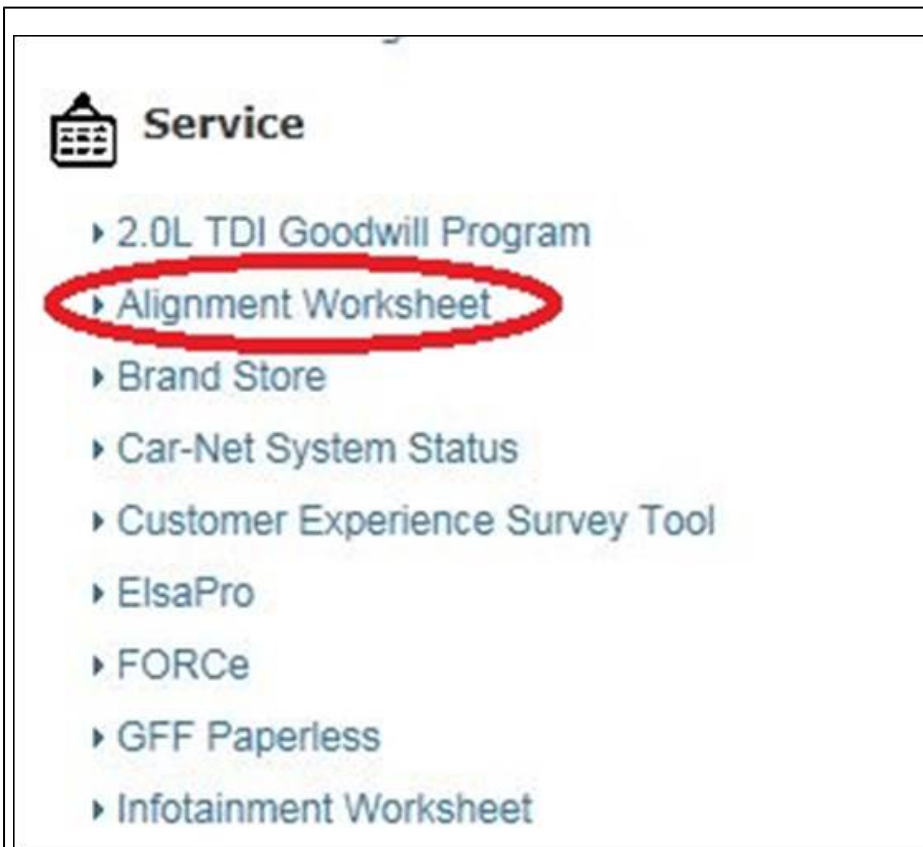

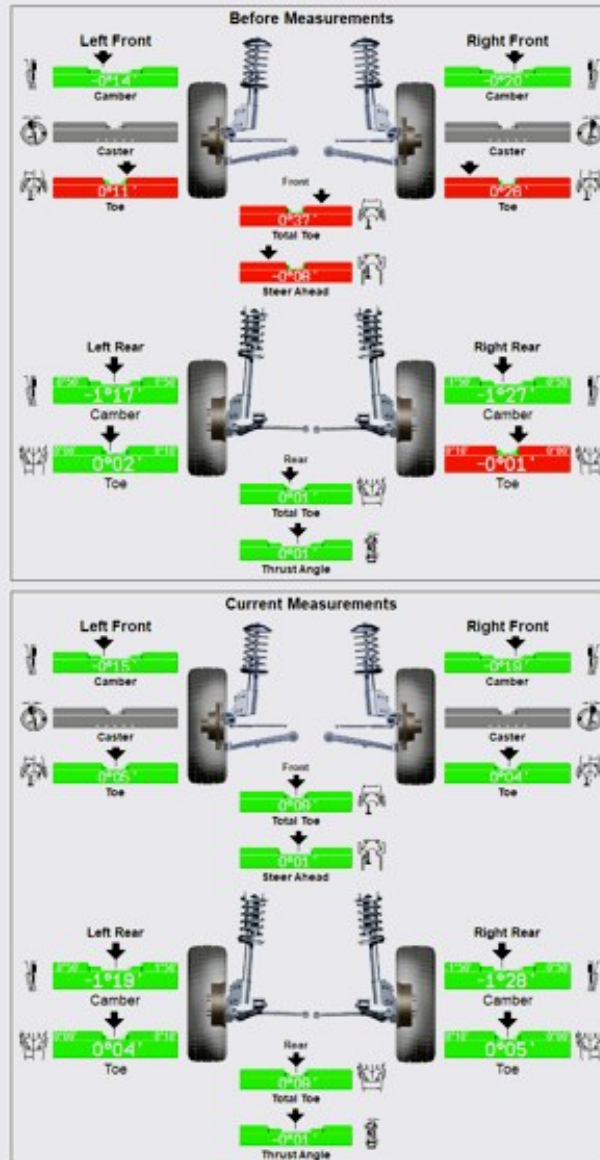

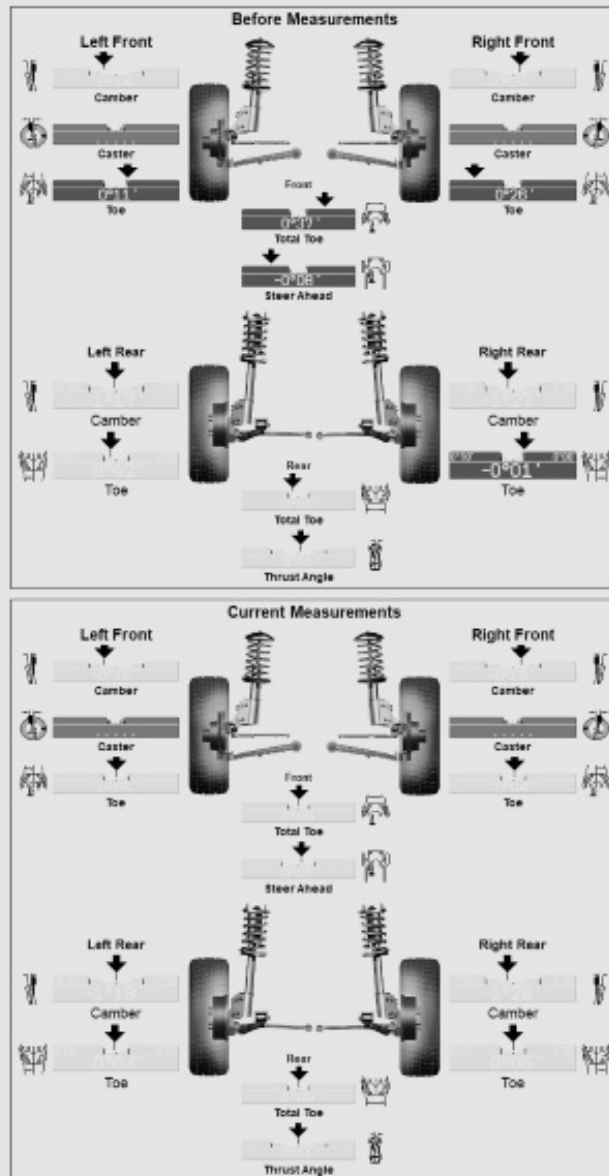
