SUBJECT: GM is expanding this recall to include an additional 389,905 MY 1995-1997 Cadillac Eldorado, Seville, and Deville model vehicles equipped with V8 LD8 and L37 engines. Some of these vehicles have a condition in which the nylon tubing used in the fuel rail construction may degrade and crack. GM Recall No. 04014.

This recall was the subject of an Engineering Analysis, EA04-003, conducted by the Office of Defects Investigation.
