Graco Children's Products Inc. (Graco) has notified NHTSA that certain Milestone child seats, model numbers 1910130, 1923980, 1926538, and 1926539, fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard number 213, "Child Restraint Systems." The affected child seat labels are missing the statement "Secure this child restraint with the vehicle's child restraint anchorage system (LATCH) if available or with a vehicle belt."


