Dear Mercedes-Benz Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Daimler AG (DAG), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Model Year 2017 Mercedes-Benz E-Class Coupe (207 platform) vehicles. Our records indicate that your vehicle is included in the affected population of vehicles. **Remedy parts are now available for your vehicle**.

What is the CONCERN?	Certain Model Year 2017 E-Class Coupe vehicles might have been built with electric power steering control units that were equipped with improperly soldered contacts. If the affected pins lose complete electrical contact, then the vehicle's electric power steering could deactivate, increasing the risk of a crash. In addition, the complete loss of electrical connection could lead to a short circuit within the control unit, increasing the risk of a fire.
What will your DEALER DO?	An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will replace the electric power steering rack on affected vehicles. <u>This service will be provided free of charge</u> . We are dedicated to always delivering the best customer experience, and respect for your time is a top priority. While the minimum repair time can be up to 2½ <b>hours</b> , your dealer can provide you with a better estimate of the overall time for this service visit. As a matter of normal service process, an authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will also check for other repair measures which might be applicable to your vehicle and this may increase the required working time.
