Chronology:

March 2017: On March 2, 2017, vehicle assembly plant personnel noted missing spot welds in the windshield header area of the sheet metal on Edge vehicles equipped with an optional Vista Roof. On March 3, 2017, the issue was brought into a CCRG for investigation. CCRG requested CAE analysis to assess the potential effect on vehicle safety and for compliance to FMVSS 214. The CAE results and engineering analysis showed potential degradation of side structural integrity during a pole impact.

On March 20, 2017, Ford's Field Review Committee reviewed the concern and approved a field action.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: Owners will be notified by mail and instructed to take their vehicle to a

Ford or Lincoln dealer to have the windshield header repaired. There will

be no charge for this service.

Ford is excluding reimbursement for costs because the original warranty

program would provide for a free repair for this concern.

Ford will forward a copy of the notification letters to dealers to the agency

when available.
