

**RECREATIONAL VEHICLE SAFETY RECALL NOTICE** Safety Recall: 17V-692 Safety Advisory: RC000148

## IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL This notice applies to your vehicle: «VIN»

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Thor Motor Coach (TMC) has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2018 motorhomes. As a result, TMC is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you; however your safety and continued satisfaction are of the utmost importance to us.

It has been decided that on certain 2018 Ace, Axis, Hurricane, Vegas & Windsport motorhomes, **Reason** for the 7-Pin wires were not properly installed in the connector. As a result, trailer tail lamps, trailer this recall stop lamps, trailer side marker lamps and trailer lighting will not function as intended. Failure of the stop lamps to illuminate when the brakes are applied may result in following road users being unaware of the driver's intentions, increasing the risk of a crash causing property damage and/or personal injury. What we TMC has contacted your selling dealer and has instructed them on how to re-wire a new trailer lighting connector. This will be done at no cost to you the owner. The remedy should take will do approximately 20 minutes to perform. What we need At your earliest convenience, please contact your dealer and schedule an appointment to have this remedy completed. If you have questions concerning this recall or if you need any you to do assistance, please contact the TMC Warranty/Service Department by mail at TMC, P.O. If you had appropriate repairs completed prior to receipt of this recall notice, and if you incurred any direct cost in connection with obtaining such repair, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement from TMC by contacting the TMC Warranty/Service Department.
