Problem Description:

Silverstone Associates LLC (Silverstone) is recalling certain Ride Eazy DOT Sleek helmets, sizes M and XL. These helmets may not adequately protect the wearer in the event of a head impact during a motorcycle crash. As such, these helmets fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) number 218, "Motorcycle Helmets."

Consequence:

A helmet that does not adequately protect the wearer from an impact can increase the risk of injury in the event of a crash.

Remedy:

Silverstone will notify owners, and provide replacement helmets, free of charge. The recall is expected to begin December 7, 2018. Owners may contact Silverstone customer service at 1-410-696-7180.
