Dear Audi Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Audi has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2009-2011 model year Audi vehicles equipped with a Takata passenger frontal airbag. Our records show that you are the owner of a vehicle affected by this action.

The passenger frontal airbag inflator could potentially explode if the vehicle is involved in a crash where the passenger frontal airbag is designed to deploy. If this happens, metal fragments could pass through the airbag material, which may result in serious injury or death to vehicle occupants.

Replacement parts are not yet available. Audi will send you another letter as soon as we can perform this recall on your vehicle. In the meantime, Audi recommends avoiding use of the front passenger seat whenever possible until the recall repair has been performed.
