On January 8, 2018, Ford's Field Review Committee approved field service action 18S02 to address these higher risk vehicles. Field Service Action program 18S02 includes the driver and passenger airbag inflators to ensure both recalled airbag inflators are replaced when the vehicle is repaired.

Owners will be instructed to contact their Ford or Lincoln dealer to have their driver and passenger frontal airbag inflators replaced. There will be no charge for this service.
