On January 19, 2018, while conducting a routine internal Quality Control audit, the manufacturing plant identified that 18 gauge wires where installed to a 30AMP circuit breaker. The manufacturing plant then contacted Forest River's Office of Corporate Compliance ("OCC") the same day and an investigation into the issue was initiated.

Forest River reviewed internal data and found no warranty claims or customer complaints potentially related to this issue.

On January 26, 2018, Forest River's Corporate Committee decided to conduct a recall.
