## **IMPORTANT NOTICE TO DEALERS - FOR IMMEDIATE DISTRIBUTION**

Volkswagen has notified NHTSA about the upcoming safety recall described in this letter.

	On Monday, February 19, 2018, check your daily campaign open inventory report or OMD for affected vehicles in your inventory.
RECALL DESCRIPTION	Affected vehicles were built with a driver airbag/steering wheel combination that was not released for the United States market. In the event of a crash with airbag deployment, the airbag may not perform as required by regulations, which may increase the risk of injury.
CORRECTIVE ACTION	As with any safety/compliance recall, affected vehicles in dealer inventory are on mandatory stop-sale hold until this recall repair has been performed.
	Under this recall, the driver airbag and steering wheel will be replaced.
	Repair information will be provided to dealers when parts and repair instructions become available to support this recall.

**IMPORTANT REMINDER ON VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS** 

<u>New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory:</u> It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

<u>Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory:</u> Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
