time, the spare tire mount could detach from the vehicle frame, causing it to

enter the roadway and increasing the risk of a crash.

Chronology:

On January 17, 2018 Forest Rivers' No Boundaries division received a warranty claim from a dealer relating to the spare tire mount. The warranty claim reported that the spare tire mount was beginning to tear away from the vehicle frame. On March 7, 2018, Forest River received a report from a customer where it was also reported that the spare tire mount had begun to tear away from the vehicle frame On March 8, 2018 the division contacted OCC. Forest River started an investigation, including a review of the spare tire mount attachment to the vehicle frame. The investigation revealed that the weight of the tire was putting excessive leverage onto the spare tire mount and the material used in the mount was insufficient for the size of the spare tire.

On March 16, 2018, Forest River's Corporate Committee decided to conduct a recall to address this issue.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: Forest River will provide a replacement a replacement spare tire mount, and labor free of charge. A dealership must install the new spare tire

mount.
