

Situation

Following quality tests performed on the above-mentioned motorcycles, we noticed potential contact between the fuel tank and/or the airbox drain hoses with the horizontal cylinder exhaust manifold. In rare circumstances this contact could create a fire hazard in the motorcycle lower LH area (under the battery). To avoid this issue, we have defined a new routing for the fuel tank and airbox drain hoses to prevent contact of the drain hoses with the horizontal cylinder exhaust manifold.



Customer Impact

All bikes in dealer stock ('to be registered' or 'already registered') and awaiting delivery to final customers must undergo this procedure during pre-delivery operations, before delivery to the final customer. All bikes already delivered to final customers must undergo this procedure at the next service appointment.

Parts Distribution

No additional parts are required for the performance of this procedure

Warranty Reimbursement

Warranty

Reimbursement for work associated with this Safety Recall Campaign will be done through the regular warranty claim procedure using the "Vehicle History" section of the DCS. The warranty claim is pre-filled and is identified as **CR156**.

You will be reimbursed for 24 minutes of labor time (4 labor units) that includes the time necessary for:

- A. Vehicle acceptance
- B. Removing and installing the LH fairing
- C. Cutting the drain hose of the coolant expansion reservoir
- D. Repositioning the fuel tank and Airbox drain hoses
- E. Light Cleaning of the vehicle



Service Solution

To perform the update process in the time provided, it is necessary to follow all instructions in the sequence of operations provided in this bulletin

- 1.0 Remove LH side fairing (See "Section 05 Faring" of the Workshop Manual)
- 2.0 Remove and retain the *L.39 mm button tie* (1) part no. 74110551A that secures the *fuel tank drain hose* (2) and the *airbox drain hose* (3)

3.0 Use a felt-tip pen to mark the coolant expansion reservoir drain hose (A) at 20 mm measured from the free end, as shown in the figure



4.0 Cut hose (A) on the mark previously made with the felt-tip pen






Before performing the cut, make sure that the marked *hose (A)* is the coolant expansion reservoir drain hose




5.0 Reposition the *fuel tank drain hose (2)* and *airbox drain hose (3*) outside the starter motor, the side stand and the Ducati Quick Shift (DQS) cables, as shown








6.0 Fit the **L.39 mm button tie (1)** and position it at <u>45 mm</u> measured from the upper edge of the groove on the *airbox drain hose (3)* terminal, as shown


- **7.0** Fit the LH side fairing by inserting the following components in this order:
 - A. Insert pin (4) in the vibration damper (5) present on the fuel tank bracket
 - B. Insert 2 pins (6) in the relevant vibration dampers (7) on the headlight
 - C. Insert pin (8) in the vibration damper (9)
 - D. Attach airbox drain hose (3) in the retaining fork on the LH side fairing









- **8.0** To fasten the LH side fairing, tighten the screws indicated below to the specified torque:
 - A. 4 M5x12 screws (10) to 2.5 Nm ± 10%
 - B. 1 M5x9 screw (11) to $4 Nm \pm 10\%$
 - C. 1 M5x18 screw (12) with spacer (13) to $2.5 \text{ Nm} \pm 10\%$
 - D. 2 M5x16 screws (14) with washer (15) to 2.5 Nm ± 10%





- 9.0 Position the *LH cover (16)* by engaging the *2 front teeth (17)* in the *slots (18)* of front subframe and the *2 teeth (19)* in the *slots (20)* of the LH fairing
- 10.0 Tighten the M5x18 screw (21) to 0.5 Nm ±10% and the M5x9 screw (22) to 2.5 Nm ± 10%

Dear Ducati Owner,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the U.S. National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act & Canada Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Ducati Motor Holding S.P.A. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in Model Year 2017 and 2018 SuperSport and SuperSport S motorcycles. Our records indicate that you are the owner of a Ducati motorcycle affected by this safety recall campaign. Please take the time to read this letter and help us take the appropriate steps to ensure that your vehicle is operating properly.

What is wrong?

Some of Ducati's SuperSport motorcycles may have been assembled with both, the airbox blow-by and fuel tank overfill hoses, routed too closely to the horizontal exhaust manifold. Under certain conditions, these hoses could melt leading to a potential risk of fire.

What will Ducati do?

To correct this condition, certified Ducati repair technicians will inspect existing hose routing and correct hose locations as needed to ensure any contact between these hoses and the exhaust manifold is avoided. This will be done in accordance with new routing procedures prescribed by Ducati Motor Holding.

The Dealer will perform this repair at no cost to you for parts and labor. We request that you contact your authorized Ducati dealer and schedule an appointment, so that the required service can be performed without delay. The repair should take approximately 30 minutes. Additional time may be required depending on dealer scheduling.
