Subject: Takata Safety Recall Update for Recall 2618F - Mazda6, Mazdaspeed6 and MPV Launch Delayed until July 6, 2018

Due to a delay with the parts collection, the subject Recalls 9416E, 0617A, and 2018A will remain open until July 6th for Mazda6, Mazdaspeed6 and MPV Vehicles. Owner letter mailings will begin July 6, 2018 instead of June 29, 2018 and parts will be available to order beginning on Friday, July 6th.

As advised on June 27th, RX-8 vehicles under Recalls 9416E, 0617A and 2018A will remain open until further notice. Parts ordering resumed for the above three recalls on Friday June 28, 2018 for all RX-8 vehicles and warranty claims will continue to be accepted. The scheduled Recall 2618F launch for the RX-8 vehicles will occur at a later date and will be communicated at that time.

We apologize for any inconvenience this recall may cause you and your customers. Your understanding and support in carrying out these recall campaigns are greatly appreciated.
