



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – UB9

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2017 and 2018 model year (GA) Alfa Romeo Giulia vehicles equipped with a 2.0L 280HP engine and All Wheel Drive (AWD).

VINs identified as being involved in this campaign are currently live and searchable. **Stop sale is in effect for the above-identified vehicles**.

Vehicles impacted by a stop sale are eligible for reimbursement allowance through the Recall Floorplan Reimbursement Policy (RFPRP), which can be requested upon recall claim submission.

<u>IMPORTANT:</u> Some of the involved vehicles may be in dealer new vehicle inventory. Federal law requires you to complete this recall service on these vehicles before retail delivery. Violation of this requirement by a dealer could result in a civil penalty of up to \$21,000 per vehicle. Involved vehicles can be determined by using the VIP inquiry process.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may experience contact between a coolant hose clamp and a brake fluid tube in the engine compartment. Over time, this contact may lead to a brake fluid leak onto the engine catalyst. If the brake fluid tube is damaged and brake fluid leaks onto the engine catalyst, the customer may smell a burning odor or see smoke, and there is a potential for an engine compartment fire which may result in an increased risk of injury to motor vehicle occupants or persons outside the vehicle.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to install a locating bracket on the brake fluid tube to control the clearance of the brake fluid tube to the coolant hose to prevent contact. If the brake fluid tube is damaged, a new brake fluid tube will be installed. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in the 4th Quarter of 2018.
