Dear Mercedes-Benz Owner,

Daimler AG (“DAG”), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain S-Class and S-Class Coupe vehicles. Our records indicate that your vehicle is included in the affected population of vehicles.

What is the Concern?

DAG determined that in certain Model Year (“MY”) 2018 S-Class and S-Class Coupe vehicles (217 and 222 platforms), the boot for the steering column may not have been installed according to production specifications. In that case, the Hands-off Detection (“HoD”) function of Active Steering Assist may incorrectly assume the driver’s hands are on the wheel. As a result, the system would not provide any warnings to return the driver’s hands to the steering wheel nor bring the vehicle to a stop, which could increase the risk of a crash.

To remedy this issue, an authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will check the steering shaft cover and adjust it if necessary. Unfortunately, the remedy is not yet available.

We are working to correct this condition as quickly as possible. When the remedy becomes available, we will send you another letter asking you to take your vehicle to an authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer to have the recall completed free of charge.

Should you have any concerns or questions regarding your vehicle before you receive the next recall letter when the remedy is available, please contact an authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer. If for any reason a dealer is unable to address your concerns or questions, we are always happy to hear from you. Please contact us at 1-(800) FOR-MERCEDES (1-800-367-6372). A new vehicle identification number (VIN)-based recall lookup tool, on our MBUSA.com website, now offers a search function that will indicate whether a vehicle has been subject to a safety recall, and whether that vehicle has had the free remedy performed. If you are no longer the vehicle owner, or have a change of address, please complete the reverse side of this letter and return the complete letter in the enclosed envelope. If this is a leased vehicle and the lessor and registered owner receive this notice, please forward this information by first class mail to the lessee within 10 days to comply with federal regulations.

If an authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer for any reason is unable to remedy the situation without charge, or within a reasonable amount of time, pursuant to law 49 U.S.C. Chapter 301, you may submit a complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue, S.E., Washington, D.C. 20590 or call the toll-free Auto Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY 1-800-424-9153); or go to <http://www.safercar.gov>.
