

OWNER NOTIFICATION **NOTIFICACIÓN PROPIETARIO**

NHTSA RECALL 18V-922

Dear Nissan Altima owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Nissan has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain Model Year 2019 Nissan Altima vehicles. Our records indicate you own or lease a Nissan vehicle subject to this recall as identified by the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) on the inside of this notice.

Reason for Recall

On some of the affected vehicles, the low pressure fuel tube retainer clip may not have been locked into position during installation. As a result, a fuel leak may occur. If the fuel leak continues, the check engine light will illuminate to warn the driver. However, if the fuel tube disconnects completely, the fuel leak may increase and potentially cause the engine to stop running unexpectedly.

What Nissan Will Do

Your Nissan dealer will inspect, and secure if necessary, both the low pressure fuel tube retainer clip and fuel hose holding clip. This repair will be made free of charge and should take less than an hour to complete. However, your dealer may require your vehicle for a longer period of time based upon their work schedule.

What You Should Do

Contact any Nissan dealer at your earliest convenience to have your vehicle remedied. Please bring this notice with you to your service appointment.
