Subject: Safety Recall SC0415c, Eaton ECA Clutches

Description of Defect:

Update: Eaton Corporation has expanded the scope of their recall as of October 18, 2019.

Eaton Corporation has determined that certain automated manual transmissions supplied by Eaton contain a safety related defect in the clutch assy. The issue as defined by Eaton is “an internal component within the clutch assembly may be outside of specification and fail, which in special circumstances could cause such clutch component to inhibit clutch departure. If the clutch departure becomes inhibited, unintended vehicle motion could occur. Accordingly, the defect can cause a vehicle impact.”

Models/ Model Years Affected:

Mack: Certain 2018 CXU model vehicles manufactured from April 18, 2017 through October 30, 2017.
2019 AN model vehicles manufactured June 21, 2018 through June 26, 2018.

Vehicle Quantities:

Mack: Approximately ~~8 vehicles~~ All US-12 vehicles (11 US and 1 Canada)

Dealer’s Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act requires dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal January 16, 2019.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before February 14, 2019.
