## **Chronology:**

On February 1, 2019 Forest River's Salem and Wildwood manufacturing plant alerted Forest River's OCC and a potential issue involving a discrepancy in the FED Tags' tire PSI listing. On February 4, 2019 and investigation was opened and scope of VINs were determined by production records that reflect the production of the affected vehicles.

On February 8th, 2019 Forest Rivers Corporate Recall Committee voted to recall.

On February 11, 2019, Forest River's OCC received evidence indicating that the WBF295BH-W, SBF295BH and SBF295BH-W sub-models are not affected. These three sub-models upon further inspection did have the correct PSI listed for the tires. The only model remaining affected is the WBF295BH. This newly identified scope reduces the total US population from 59 vehicles to 25.
