The wire harness that connects the Occupant Detection System (ODS) to the mat sensor, if broken, will result in deployment of the front passenger airbag regardless of seat occupant. The recalled vehicles were not produced in VIN order. Customers seeking information about their specific vehicle will be referred to Kia's Consumer Assistance

Center or their Kia dealer.

Description of the Defect: The wiring harness underneath the front passenger seat which connects the

Occupant Detection System (ODS) unit to the mat sensor is kept in place by clips. When the seat is occupied by a passenger, the weight of the passenger on the seat cushion may cause the wire harness to bend. Over time, repeated bending can break the wire harness. If the wire harness breaks, the ODS will

not suppress the front passenger airbag.

instructions to bring their vehicles to a Kia dealer. Dealers will be instructed to remove the wire harness clip between the ODS control unit and the mat sensor on the affected vehicles to prevent the wiring harness from bending. Also, if the wiring harness is found damaged, dealers will be instructed to replace the front passenger seat cushion. Kia will reimburse owners for repair expenses already incurred pursuant to Kia's General

Reimbursement Plan filed April 10, 2018.
