## Safety Recall: Driver's Airbag Replacement Inflator Can Be Over-Pressurized (Module Replacement)

## **AFFECTED VEHICLES**

Year	Model	Trim	VIN Range

## **BACKGROUND**

In certain vehicles, the **replacement** driver's (front) airbag inflator (from either a previous recall repair or an airbag module replacement) could produce excessive internal pressure during airbag deployment. If an affected airbag deploys, the increased internal pressure may cause the inflator casing to rupture. Metal fragments could pass through the airbag cushion material, possibly causing injury or fatality to vehicle occupants.

When this temporary placeholder bulletin appears during an iN VIN Status Inquiry, this vehicle is subject to a Safety Recall. This vehicle is on **STOP SALE** until further notice. Check for an iN message for further details. Refrain from calling Tech Line for updates.

This bulletin will be updated once Parts Information, Warranty Claim Information, Inspection Procedures, and Repair Procedures are available.
