Audi has decided that certain 2016-2018 model year Audi Q3 vehicles fail to conform to FMVSS 108: *Lamps, Reflective Devices, and Associated Equipment*. What is the issue?

Due to an incorrect software configuration a failure of an LED front turn signal may not be detected and the customer would not be alerted by a fast-flashing of the internal pilot indicator. The turn signals in the exterior mirrors still work as intended. Loss of turn signal function, without a warning to the driver, could increase the risk of a crash.

What will we do?

To correct this noncompliance, your authorized Audi dealer will update the BCM software in your vehicle. This work will take about an hour to complete and will be performed for you free of charge. Please keep in mind that your dealer may need additional time for the preparation of the repair, as well as to accommodate their daily workshop schedule.

What should you do?
