#### **Chronology:**

A Product Safety and Compliance Committee (PSCC) investigation was opened on March 26, 2019, following an Engineering Analysis request from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) to review further claims of unlatched doors while in motion from the previous P068 recall population.

A Jaguar Land Rover Engineering investigation was conducted to understand the nature of the error state in the door latches and the scope of the issue.

During the investigation in April, 2019, the engineering team reviewed all available data including assessment of field return components. The engineering team conducted ongoing discussion with the door latch supplier in regards to the prior investigation and other potential issues which may impact the ability of the Unilatch Keyless Vehicle (KV) door latch to correctly operate.

In late April 2019, detailed analysis of reports relating to vehicles repaired previously in the P068 recall campaign was conducted. This detailed analysis engendered a detailed assessment of post-P068 repaired vehicles and causes of the post-P068 recall failures.

This data analysis was reviewed at the PSCC on April 30, 2019, along with the reasons why the P068 recall

remedy did not prevent the failure mode for which it was launched. Based on the information and data presented, the matter was progressed to the Recall Determination Committee (RDC).

The RDC reviewed the investigation on May 16, 2019, and concluded that there is a pattern and trend related to vehicles where failure to latch is occurring in vehicles repaired after the P068 recall had been completed. RDC agreed the issue represented an unreasonable risk to safety and that a voluntarily safety recall be conducted.

There have been no reported accidents or injuries as a result of this concern.

## **Description of Remedy:**

Description of Remedy Program: Owners will be notified and instructed to take their vehicle to Land Rover approved repairer who will download the latest software. This software will disable the Unilatch Keyless Vehicle (KV) entry function on the vehicle.

> A check of the KV system (motor operation) will indicate if the KV system has no pre-existing error state prior to latest software update being applied. Should any issue be detected, affected KV mechanisms will be mechanically disabled.

There will be no charge to owners for this repair.

Customers who have paid for a repair of this defect will be reimbursed by the Jaguar Land Rover reimbursement plan, subject to the usual terms and conditions.
