September 2018, DTNA received a report of a brake caliper with low torque on a vehicle at the Mt Holly manufacturing plant. The axle assembly plant was audited. The audit revealed that on certain vehicles, the specified process to fully torque fasteners may not have been followed, so proper torque cannot be guaranteed. October 2018, out of an abundance of caution, DTNA decided to initiate a voluntary safety recall for specific vehicles equipped with air disc brakes where the brake caliper mounting bolts may be incorrectly torqued.
