Dear Peterbilt Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt has decided that certain Model 320 and 520 vehicles manufactured between June 17, 1989 and April 06, 2019 fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 108. These vehicles include amber stop lamps that illuminate simultaneously with red stop lamps when the brake is applied. The amber stop lamps may confuse other drivers and cause a vehicle crash without prior warning. Your vehicle has been identified as having amber stop lamps.

<i>The problem is...</i>	Amber stop lamps may illuminate when the brake is applied.
<i>What your dealer will do...</i>	Dealer will inspect and if necessary remove the amber lamps and wiring
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Contact your nearest Peterbilt dealer to schedule an appointment

Your Peterbilt dealer is available immediately to remedy this issue at no cost to you. To find your Peterbilt dealer, please visit Dealer Locator at www.Peterbilt.com. This repair may take up to 1.0 hours of labor depending on dealer scheduling.

If you had this repair performed before receiving this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. Receipts for parts and/or labor are required for consideration of reimbursement.
