



Safety Recall: Jayco 19V-516 2019-341
July 2019

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

Dear Valued Dealer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Jayco has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Model Year 2019 and 2020 White Hawk travel trailers.

<i>Reason for this recall</i>	The wiring of the emergency brake, breakaway trailer switch may be incorrect. Incorrect wiring of the switch will prevent the trailer brakes from functioning as a safety system if the trailer would separate from the tow vehicle, increasing the risk of a crash.
<i>Recall Remedy</i>	Inspect the breakaway switch for proper wiring and rewire as required.

The TSB 19-032 released in June to address this incident, is now classified as a **Safety Recall** under the Recall numbers 19V-516 (US) and 2019-341 (CN). The repair remains the same. If the repair was completed under the TSB another repair is NOT required under the Recall.
