This is to notify you of a new Recall Campaign regarding the battery mounting bracket on 26,584 Model Year ("MY") 2018-2019 C-Class (205 platform) vehicles. The recall campaign will be visible on the <a href="www.safercar.gov">www.safercar.gov</a> website and may generate questions from customers. Affected VINs will be flagged in VMI as "PENDING" on August 16, 2019.				
Background				
Issue		Daimler AG ("DAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain Model Year ("MY") 2018-2019 C-Class vehicles (205 platform) the mounting bracket for the 12V starter battery might not have been manufactured according to current production specification. If the battery is not properly secured, it could shift and disconnect the terminals in the event of a crash. If this were to occur, the vehicle's power supply would be interrupted, impairing different post-crash functionalities. Furthermore, if the battery detaches from the vehicle in a crash, it could become a road hazard, increasing the risk of injury for other road users.		
What We're Doing		MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will replace the battery mounting bracket on the affected vehicles.		
Parts		A remedy is not yet available. An additional notification will be sent once a remedy is available.

Loaner and demonstrator vehicles may continue to be driven, but must not be retailed until repaired.  Additionally, given this notice, it is <u>a violation of Federal Law</u> for <u>car rental companies</u> to rent new MY18-19 C-Class vehicles covered by this notification until the vehicle has been repaired.
