This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Autocar, LLC has determined that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in 33, 2019-2020 model year Xpeditor chassis. These chassis were manufactured between September 7, 2018 and July 18, 2019 with non-sequential serial numbers in the range 228668 through 231646. Accordingly, a recall to address this issue is being initiated effective October 18, 2019.

Power Steering Pump Mounting Bolts

SAFETY DEFECTS AND POTENTIAL

RISKS:

The power steering pump mounting bolts may not be properly secured. If the power steering pump becomes disconnected, a sudden increase of steering effort could result in loss of vehicle control, increasing the risk of a crash, personal injury or property

damage.

REPAIR REQUIRED: The power steering pump mounting bolts will be properly secured at no charge to the

owner.

REPAIR AVAILABLE: VIN profiles in the Autocar Warranty System will be updated to show the open recall on October 18, 2019 and a spreadsheet of the affected VINs will be available in the

Warranty system.

REMINDER:

It is a violation of Federal law to sell or lease a vehicle covered by this recall notice unless the recall remedy has been completed. Substantial civil penalties apply to

violations of this law.
