New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – VA6

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain Right Hand Drive (RHD) 2011 - 2018 Model Year (JK) Jeep® Wrangler vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles built for rural mail carriers may experience fatigue loading of the seat belt buckle which could lead to its mounting strap fracturing and separating from the seat cushion frame. A seat belt buckle mounting strap that separates from the seat frame results in the seat belt system being inoperative, which may increase the risk of injury and/or injury severity to the driver in a vehicle crash.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to replace the driver's seat belt buckle. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 4th Quarter of 2019.
