IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL - NHTSA Recall No. 19V-696

Dear Lamborghini Owner, Lessee,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Automobili Lamborghini S.p.A. has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain Model Year 2017-2019 Aventador S Coupè and Roadster vehicles. Our records indicate that you are the owner of a vehicle in this recall.

What is the issue?

The affected vehicles might, under certain driving conditions (accelerator pedal released in the idle approach to a stop) present an engine stall event without warning. An engine stall can increase the risk of a crash.

In the mentioned conditions, the engine management software doesn't assure the idle minimum revs in order to maintain the engine running with consequent possible engine stall.

The engine can switch off approaching a stop at idle, increasing the risk of a crash. However, it is still possible to restart the engine after the problem occurrence

For all the reason set forth above, it is therefore necessary to update these vehicles. If you are not the only driver of this vehicle, please advise all other drivers and passengers of this important information.

What Do You Need to Do?

The software update needed to repair this condition is not yet available. Once the update becomes available, Lamborghini will send you a separate letter with further instructions on how you can make an appointment with your authorized Lamborghini dealer to have the vehicle software updated, free of charge.

What will Lamborghini do?

We will update the engine software to the latest version "Free of Charge". The repair could take up to 1 hour. We apologize for any inconvenience this recall may cause. Please bring this letter and your Service Booklet with you when you visit the dealer, so that we can make all necessary entries.

What if you are not the current owner of this vehicle?

You can update your vehicle ownership or contact information by filling out the enclosed document (Appendix A) and sending it to Lamborghini by following the detailed instructions present on it.

If you are a vehicle lessor, Federal Regulations require you to forward this notice to your lessee within ten days.

What if you have questions or experience problems?

You may be eligible for a refund of previously paid repairs. In case you have been charged for a repair related to an engine stall event, Lamborghini will verify the service history and proceed with the full reimbursement in case the defect is directly related to this recall content.

We sincerely apologize for any inconvenience this recall may cause; however, be assured that Lamborghini is concerned about your safety and security.
