9/12/2019 - Peterbilt Safety and Compliance was notified by the Denton plant that an incorrect bill of materials change may have affected the installation of back of sleeper conspicuity tape on certain Model 579 trucks built with a sleeper box. The conspicuity tape may have been installed inboard toward the vertical center line of the sleeper back wall as opposed to the required upper right and left contours of the sleeper back wall, as close to the top of the sleeper and as far apart as practicable. Engineering was notified of the bill of material change error and subsequently initiated corrective actions to correct the subject bill.

9/13/2019 - All affected trucks at Denton plant were remedied.

10/8/2019 - the Peterbilt Safety Committee met and decided a regulatory noncompliance existed and a recall will be required.
