Chronology:

May 29, 2019: The Audi Product Safety Committee decided to conduct a world-wide safety recall for front and rear wheel arch trim coming loose due to fastening hooks that did not properly latch.

July 2019: Analysis of new field cases indicated a new issue of the rear wheel arch trim coming loose. Further analysis and investigation commenced.

August 01, 2019: Information about this new topic was presented to the Audi Product Safety Committee. The committee requested additional testing and analysis to be performed.

August - September 2019: Analysis of field reports from different countries, investigation of root cause and contributing factors, testing of different mounting processes and parts took place. Regular updates were provided to the Audi Product Safety Committee on the progress of these analysis activities.

October 09, 2019: Investigation results were presented to the Audi Product Safety Committee. A second failure mode was identified on the rear wheel arch trim, only involving the fastening clips that are used to secure the wheel arch trim in addition to the hooks that were involved in the previous recall. The Audi Product Safety Committee made a determination of a safety defect and a new world-wide recall campaign for all Q5/SQ5 vehicles manufactured from SOP to approximately CW 35/2019 was decided.
