Descriptive Information: Customer reported the beam clip used in the air hose spring installation came off in

multiple units of theirs. During investigation, it was believed this was due to its installation by not securing properly to the beam. A second customer then reported the same issue, hence proceeded to investigate further with our vendor. Upon testing the strength/grip of the beam clip, discovered a defect causing beam clip to fall off of the beam when force is applied. Agreed with vendor to replace the beam clip in the spring assembly for a more resistant beam clip. New beam clip passed all tests hence

agreed to replace on the affected units.

April 2019, customer reported the beam clip which holds the air hose spring detached from the beam (cross member) causing the air hoses to hit the ground. This happened on multiple of their units. Upon investigation, it was believed this was due to installation.

June 2019. Second customer reports same issue. Contacted part supplier for assistance and tested the beam clip. Test results showed defect in material hence grip/strength on clip was lower than required. July 2019. Identified production lot with defective material and compiled customer related information September 2019. Agreed to new beam clip that would replace defective beam clip.

October 2019. Compiled customer contact information, VIN list and repair procedure.
