If the contact pins are not soldered according to current production specifications, the control unit and the electric motor could lose complete electrical connection, resulting in the loss of the electric power steering assist, and increasing the risk of a crash. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will replace the electric power steering control unit on the affected vehicles.

Prior to performing this Recall Campaign:

- Please check VMI to determine if the vehicle is involved in the Campaign and if it has been previously repaired. Always Check VMI for any open campaigns, and perform accordingly.
