Daimler AG ('DAG'), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that certain GLE-Class vehicles (166 platform) were fitted with an incorrect tire pressure label at the B-pillar that lists incorrect seating capacity figures and tire dimensions on front and rear axles, and therefore fail to comply with FMVSS 110 (Tires Selection and Rims). As a precautionary measure an authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will check the tire pressure label at the B-pillar on the affected vehicles and replace it, if necessary.

Prior to performing this Recall Campaign:

- Please check VMI to determine if the vehicle is involved in the Campaign and if it has been previously repaired.
- Please review the entire Recall Campaign bulletin and follow the repair procedure exactly as described.
- Please place an order for the tire pressure label according to the VIN.

Please note that Recall Campaigns **do not expire** and may also be performed on a vehicle with a vehicle status indicator.

Approximately 64 vehicles are involved.




Figure 1 (Sample information label)
