Audi has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain Auburn Hills, MI 48326 2012-2014 model year Audi A6 and A7 vehicles. What is the issue?

The fuel line was designed with a compression point to assist in installation. This area of the fuel line may weaken and leak over time. Leaking fuel, in the presence of an ignition source, can lead to a fire.

What will we do?

To correct this defect, your authorized Audi dealer will inspect and, if necessary, replace the affected fuel line. This work will take about three hours to complete and will be performed for you free of charge.

What should you do?

Parts for this repair will be available at authorized Audi dealers on February 19, 2018. Please contact your authorized Audi dealer without delay to schedule this recall repair.
