The existence of the condition was initially identified through surveillance testing completed on August 11, 2020. A product restriction was immediately issued and production records reviewed. Cooper Tire concluded that tires produced during weeks 2920 through 3220 may have the condition. A search of internal inventories was completed. Cooper Tire's Compliance Committee met on September 10, 2020 and determined that a potential safety condition exists in the subject tires and is voluntarily recalling the 1,983 tires. There have been no property damage or death or injury claims associated with any of these tires.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: Cooper Tire & Rubber Company (Cooper Tire) will initiate a voluntary safety recall of the subject tires. Cooper Tire will contact registered owners that purchased tires of the specified date range by registered mail. Customer correspondence will explain the issue, and include instructions on how to obtain replacement tires, as well as instructions for collecting reimbursement for remedies made prior to recall. The 1,983 tires with affected identification numbers should be returned to one of Cooper Tire & Rubber Company's Regional Inspection Points, where they will be inspected for the affected DOT tire identification numbers. All tires found to have an affected DOT identification number will be replaced and will be scrapped according to applicable law. Consumer who have had their tires replaced before this recall may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.

> In accordance with the provisions of 49 C.F.R. § 573.6(c) (9) (i), Cooper Tire & Rubber Company will make dealers aware of the legal requirements associated with the prohibition against the sale of recalled tires through a Dealer Notification Letter that will be submitted to the agency separately pursuant to 49 C.F.R. § 573.6(c)(10). The program for disposing of all recalled tires returned to Cooper Tire & Rubber Company will comply with applicable state and local laws and regulations regarding the disposal of tires, and to the extent possible, tires will be channeled into a category of positive reuse or another alternative beneficial non-vehicular reuse, instead of being disposed of in landfills.

How Remedy Component Differs The remedy components will differ from the recalled components in that from Recalled Component: they will have a unique brand, size, or DOT code. The recalled components are COOPER CS5 GRAND TOURING, DOT code U9 00 1CW 2920 through 3220, and MASTERCRAFT LSR GRAND TOURING, DOT code U9 00 FY7 2920 through 3220.
