This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. KZRV has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2020 KZ Connect SE models. As a result, KZRV is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you; however, your safety and continued satisfaction are of the utmost importance to us.

Reason for this recall

The vehicles subject to this recall were built with propane lines that are too close to the tire. The line could become damaged by debris which results in a gas leak that could result in a fire or explosion resulting in personal injury or death.

What we will do

The remedy is to reroute the propane line away from the path of the tire. The repair should take approximately 1 hour to complete.

What we need you to do

You should contact your selling dealer immediately to schedule a service appointment to have the defect repaired in your vehicle.
