Re: Recall of 2019-2020 QUAT Trailers

Dear Owner,

On March 11, 2020, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) announced a recall of certain 2019-2020 QUAT trailers. The recall is due to an incorrect cargo weight label on the trailer, which may result in the trailer being overloaded and potentially causing a crash.

Problem Description: Concession Nation has determined that certain 2019-2020 QUAT trailers have an incorrect cargo weight label. The label incorrectly states a maximum cargo weight of 11,000 lbs, when the actual maximum cargo weight is 11,500 lbs. This discrepancy may result in the trailer being overloaded, which could compromise its structural integrity and lead to a crash.

Consequence: The weight of the cargo should not exceed the weight limit. If the trailer is overloaded, it may compromise its structural integrity and lead to a crash. Incorrect cargo weight information may result in a vehicle's handling, thereby increasing the risk of a crash.

Remedy: Repa & the customer has to affix the new label enclosed in the spot of your current tire & loading sticker.

If you are the lessor of this trailer, please forward this information to the lessee within 30 days to comply with federal regulations.

If the trailer is loaded or is unable to be loaded, without charge, within a reasonable period of time, you may submit a complaint to NHTSA. Alternatively, you may call the NHTSA's toll-free hotline at 888-327-4236 (TTY 800-424-9393).

While this recall may cause some inconvenience, your safety is our first concern.
