Insufficient water drainage from the tires could affect driving performance and tire traction and therefore increase the risk of a crash. An authorized Mercedes-Benz or Freightliner Sprinter dealer will check the respective rotational direction of the tires on the affected vehicles and, if required, implement them if necessary.


