Background				
Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain Model Year ("MY") 2019-2020 G-Class vehicles (463 platform), the embossed lock symbol for the child safety lock operating lever on the rear doors might indicate the incorrect locking status of the child safety lock. In this case, the incorrectly embossed symbol could lead to a misinterpretation of the locking status of the child safety lock. As a result, the rear doors could be opened from the inside despite the indication of a locked door. Conversely, the rear doors could not be opened from the inside despite the symbol indicating that the rear door is unlocked. This could increase the risk of injury to the occupants in the second seat row. In the Operator's Manual, the operating direction of the child safety lock is stated and described correctly.				
What We're Doing	T	An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will install a label on the rear doors with the correct child safety lock status.		
Parts		Parts are not yet available for repair. However, the current remedy is not available at this time.
