This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. KZRV has decided that a non-compliance which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2018 KZ Escape models. As a result, KZRV is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you; however, your safety and continued satisfaction are of the utmost importance to us.

Reason for this recall	It has been decided that the vehicles in the recall population fail to conform to the requirements of Part 567 and Part 571.110. The vehicles subject to this recall have been manufactured with the incorrect information on the Federal Identification Tag and Tire Inflation Pressure Label. The labels indicate a Gross Axle Weight Rating (GAWR) of 5,000 lbs., a tire size of ST225/75R15E, a rim size of 15X6J, and an tire inflation pressure of 80 psi. The correct labels should indicate a Gross Axle Weight Rating (GAWR) of 3,500 lbs., a tire size of ST205/75R14D, a rim size of 14X5.5J, and an tire inflation pressure of 65 psi. An incorrect label may lead to unintentionally over inflating the tires, increasing the risk of a crash.
What we will do	We have enclosed the corrected labels to remedy the non-compliance.
What we need you to do	At your earliest convenience, apply the new Federal Identification Tag and Tire Inflation Pressure Label over top of the existing labels. Please clean the surface before applying the new labels. This repair should take 10 minutes. You should contact your selling dealer immediately to schedule a service appointment if you require assistance in performing this remedy. If you had appropriate repairs completed prior to receipt of this recall notice, and if you incurred any direct cost in connection with obtaining such repair, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement from KZRV by contacting the KZRV Warranty/Service Department .
