A list of involved vehicles in dealer new inventory NOT successfully programmed via OTA will be provided to the affected dealers on Wednesday, August 26th. Dealers can and should perform this bulletin on any vehicle with an "open" status in IVH. <u>Due to the fact that vehicles will continue to be closed in IVH through successful OTA programming, dealers should always check the status in IVH before performing any vehicle repairs.</u>
