Descriptive Information: Steering pinch bolts installed but not torqued to specification. Eight units were

produced without steering bolts being put on during production because we had none in inventory. We let the units continue in production with intentions of catching them at the end of production. They were caught and bolts installed. However, of the 8

units, one unit did not get torqued correctly when bolts were installed.

Description of the Defect: Eight units went through production without steering bolts being installed due

to inventory shortage. At the end of the line the bolts were installed and torqued to specification. Tiffin missed torquing one bolt on one unit.

could lead to vehicle crash due to no control.

Chronology:

On 8/27/2020 VIN 5VBBAK7A0LA120936 notified Tiffin. Customer stated a loss of steering control on their coach. Tiffin had the coach towed to our facility that day to be inspected. On 8-28-20 Tiffin declared that one of the steering pinch bolts that was installed had not been torqued to specification. At that point, due to the seriousness of the problem, Tiffin called all eight of the units that had went through production without the steering bolts installed until end of production line. That was to make sure the other 7 had been torqued correctly after installation of the steering bolts. A visual inspection is all that is required. Photos were sent in on some, some were inspected by dealers, some by the customers themselves under our guidance.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program : The remedy is to torque the steering bolts to specification. The inspection

is based on criteria that can be visually inspected.

The threads extended through the nuts of the bolts should have 3 to 6 threads visible if torqued correctly. There will be a colored drop of torque seal visible if torqued correctly. I do have pictures if this needs a better

visual explanation.
