Condition

When Model Y is towing a trailer, the brake lamps on the trailer are required to illuminate upon the actuation of the service brake. A software error in certain Model Y vehicles equipped with a global rear lamp variant and a tow package configuration may prevent the towed trailer brake lamps from illuminating upon actuation of the service brake.

Correction

Inspect the firmware version operating on the vehicle and update it as necessary according to the procedure steps.

Procedure

- 1. On the vehicle touchscreen, touch **Controls** (vehicle icon) > **Software**, and scroll down to display the vehicle firmware version.
- 2. If the vehicle is operating with firmware version:
 - 2020.35.101.06, then no further action is necessary
 - 2020.36.12, then no further action is necessary
 - 2020.40.3 or a newer release than 2020.40.3, then no further action is necessary
 - Any other version, then update to the latest available firmware release.
