The same day, the Corporate Quality Inspector contacted Forest Rivers Office of Corporate Compliance ("OCC") and an investigation was started.

The same day, the manufacturing plant contacted a number of dealers to have them inspect for this condition. The condition was found on vehicles manufactured from July 2020 through October 2020.

Furnace exhaust may enter the vehicle through the fresh air intake. This condition may lead to carbon monoxide (CO) poisoning, which may result in personal injury or death.

On October 23, 2020 Forest Rivers Corporate Recall Committee voted to recall
