September 22, 2020 Autocar service team reported a ground cable length concern. An internal corrective action was created and assigned to the product integrity team. October 2020 Autocar's product Integrity team investigated the concern and determined the ground cable length to be inadequate. All in-house units were corrected utilizing re-worked ground cables. October 30, 2020 All pertinent information regarding the concern is presented to Autocar management team and the decision is made to perform a voluntary safety recall for all affected units.

#### **Description of Remedy:**

Description of Remedy Program: Autocar will voluntarily initiate an owner notification and recall of all affected vehicles. Autocar will distribute to owners of affected vehicles an Owner Notification Letter, which will describe the defect and provide instructions for scheduling the inspection/repair of the vehicle at no cost to the vehicle's owner. The owner letter will instruct vehicle owners who have paid to have this condition remedied prior to this campaign to seek reimbursement pursuant to Autocar's General Reimbursement Plan, on file with the agency pursuant to 49 C.F.R. 573.6(c)(8)(i) and 49 C.F.R 573.13.
